Year 9 to Year 10 Choosing to complete a VCE subject in Year 10

Students who are at least at the expected AUSVELS level in English, Maths and the domain of proposed subject choice, and are putting in at least 'Very Good' effort in all their subjects according to their most recent report, will receive automatic entry into their VCE subject of preference.

Students who are not working at the expected level or are not putting in a 'Very Good' effort across their subjects will need to go through an application and interview process, and develop a study plan that details how they propose to succeed in a VCE subject.

Year 10 to Year 11 Choosing VCE or VET subjects

Students who are at least at the expected AUSVELS level in English, Maths and the domains of proposed subject choices, and are putting in at least 'Very Good' effort in all their subjects according to their most recent report, will receive automatic entry into the VCE or VET program.

Students who are not working at the expected level or are not putting in a 'Very Good' effort across their subjects will need to go through an application and interview process, and develop a study plan that details how they propose to successfully complete VCE or VET subjects.



Year 11 Choosing VCE Unit 3/4 subjects

Students who are at Satisfactory levels in all outcomes in VCE Units 1 & 2 of their Year 11 subject choices, and are putting in at least 'Very Good' effort in all their subjects according to their most recent report, will receive automatic entry into the VCE or VET program.

Students who are not working at a Satisfactory level and/or are not putting in a 'Very Good' effort across their subjects will need to go through an application and interview process, and develop a study plan that details how they propose to successfully complete VCE or VET subjects.
